ACTIVITY REPORT OF AN EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO NETAJI BHAWAN

Students of Semester 1 (SEC-I) and Semester 3 (SEC A-I) of the Department of History, Gokhale Memorial Girls' College visited Netaji Bhawan, Kolkata on 18th of January, 2024 under the supervision of a Faculty Member of the Department, Ms. Sanjukta De. It was a one-day Educational visit to the House of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose which now has immense historical value.

Objective of the Visit: To experience the Bose House which was built by Bose's father Janakinath Bose, in the year 1909 CE. The house was a hub of political activity once. Netaji is said to have lived here during his formative years and for most parts of the freedom struggle. Students want to experience this 115 years old residential place and to understand its Historical and Cultural background.

Outcome of the Visit:

Students of Semester I and Semester 3 really enjoyed this visit. They took time to wander around each and every room / gallery of this Place and also took a couple of pictures. They understood the vitality of this place in the 20th century in Colonial Bengal and its importance in the freedom struggle. They want to understand how it has been transformed into this excellent Archival Museum now. After visiting Netaji Bhawan, students of Semester I and 3 have prepared a Report and a PPT presentation individually on it. This will be considered one of the important Departmental activities of 2024. Details have been given following the instructions.
