3. Sukanya Naskar received two prizes, one was for college topper and another was a memorial award, on the Annual Day 08.05.23.



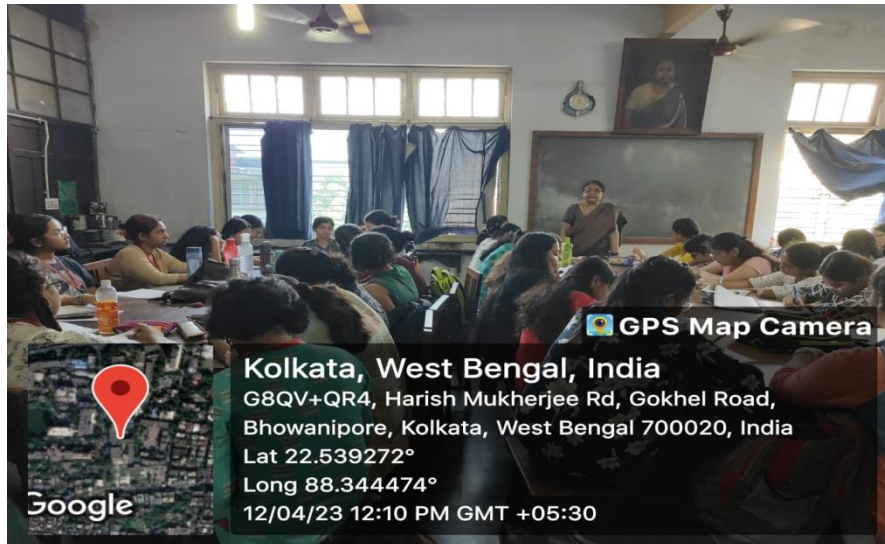

24. Suparna Sinha , student of Semester V received the certificate for volunteered the blood donation camp.

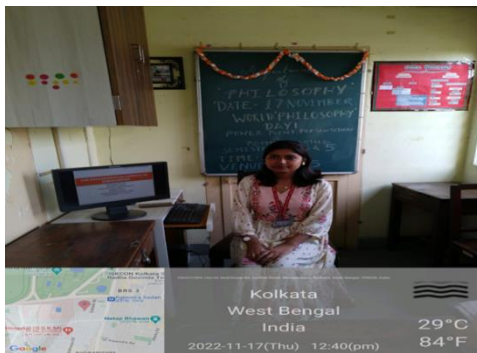
25. Shruti Chatterjee and Sonia Adhikari students of semester V went to Dakshineswar under the Social outreach Programme by college on 26.11.22.

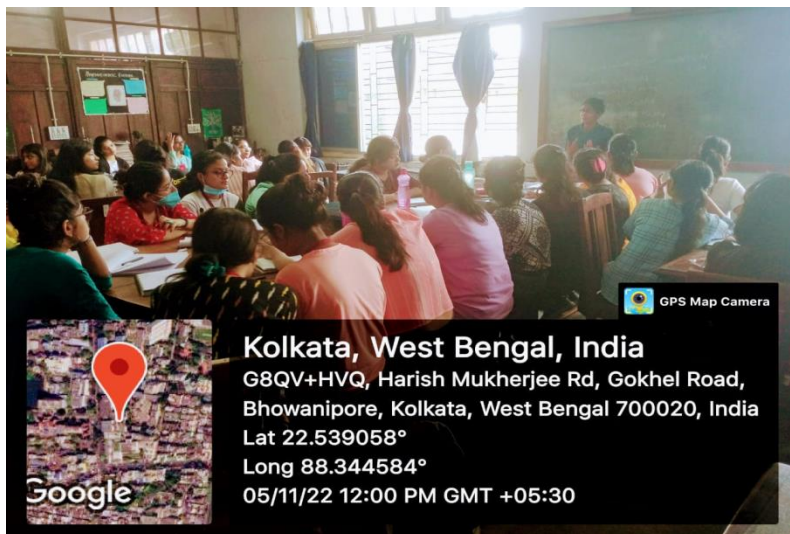
28. Debosmita Jana student of Semester III and all students of Semester I participated and volunteered for thalassemia testing/ screening programme on 24.11.22.

56. A Quiz competition was organised by the Department on 22.3.22 for the students of all semester.



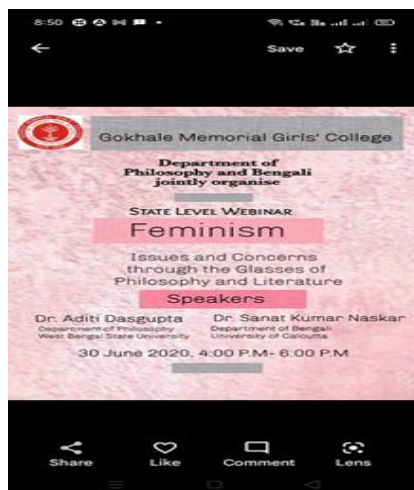
