## 1. Promoting female hygiene & health as part of "Swachh Bharat" initiative

Hence an incinerator was also installed for proper disposal of used napkins. The objective was also to help students prevent spread of infection and ensure a safe environment for all.

## 2. Promoting ICT- enabled learning by becoming a local chapter of NPTEL, MHRD initiative

Gokhale Memorial Girls' College and NPTEL and jointly organized the "**NPTEL Awareness Workshop**" for the faculty and students of the College on 14/01/2017. The workshop was conducted by Sri Biswajit Chowdhury, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics and the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the College.
