Debatrayee Dhar was awarded a Certificate Achievement for successfully completing The Everest Base Camp Trek in October 2021. The trek spanned approximately 162 kms. It took her to the foot of the world's highest peak, Mount Everest, in the heart of the majestic Himalayas, a new country, its warm people, treasured culture, exotic wildlife and their "Sel roti". The main journey began from Lukla (world's most dangerous airport) across deep dark forests, famous suspension bridges, rugged trails and a few woof woof's along the way and ultimately to the foothills of the 5,364 metres giant. The Kala Patthar at 5,644.5 metres was a very difficult trek and covered overnight to enjoy the sunrise on top of it. This trek was a dream come true for an 18-year old solo trekker who got to wave the Indian flag at 5,364 metres, one of the proudest moments of her life as recalled.
