3. **Aim of the Seminars/conferences/workshops:** The lecture was based on a large sample of student subjects who were invited to record the fact whether their right-hand DR is in the top (High type) or bottom (low type) tercile for the gender. The paper finds that higher exposure to testosterone males expend significantly higher conflict effort, are more aggressive which reduces their opponents earning. Among Females everyone is more aggressive against the High type. The paper highlights the importance of biological aspects in the ex-ante determinants of conflicts and on contest design.
