She had pursued two months 'Critical Care and Burn Nutrition' Course from IAPEN at Choithram Hospital & Research Centre, Indore and won First Prize at Case study poster presentation at IDA National Conference 2017 on 'Diabetic 36% third-degree Burn Patient recovery.'

The resource person left no stone unturned in covering the topic's all aspects in details. 


