## <u>Government of West Bengal</u> <u>Department of Higher Education</u> <u>Infrastructure Development Scheme for Government-Aided Colleges</u> (<u>Annexure to Memorandum No. 930 - Edn (CS)/10M-59/2019</u>, <u>dated 20.6.2019</u>)

This is a scheme for sanction of grant-in-aid to different Government aided colleges under the Government of West Bengal to cater to their infrastructural needs towards improvement of academic standards.

- There are two components
  - 1) Building grant for construction/repair of college building or part of the building
  - 2) Development grant for purchase of furniture, laboratory equipment, computers and peripherals.

Any college can apply for either or both the components.

# Maximum amount that can be applied for in one Financial Year-

- 1. Building grant: Rs. 3 Crore.
- 2. Development grant: Rs. 50 Lakh.

# Minimum requirements for sanction of funds:

- 1. College authority must apply as per the prescribed format within the specified period.
- 2. College authority should attach GB resolution, UC of last allotment pending, if any.
- 3. College authority should enclose an estimate (vetted by competent authorities) for building grant.
- 4. College authority should provide an undertaking that procurement out of Development Grant would be as per extant procurement guidelines of Finance Department.

# Prioritization of Colleges for sanction of fund:

Preference will be given to the following colleges in sanctioning funds -

Colleges which:

- Have formed Anti ragging committees as prescribed by UGC.
- Have made the campus tobacco free,
- Formed Sexual Harassment Committee (ICC),
- Use e /virtual class rooms regularly,
- Have introduced Bio-metric attendance of teachers / non-teaching staff.
- Or if it is a newly set-up College.
